Supportive community members such as yourself help ensure that the Great War Memorial Hospital Foundation of Perth & District can help fill the gaps where government funding stops.

With your support, we can continue purchasing state-of-the-art equipment and facilities to enhance and save local lives.

Your annual donation is integral to ensuring that the PSFDH will continue to operate at this high standard. It enables us to give our Healthcare Professionals the tools they need to provide the best possible care to every patient at the Great War Memorial site of the Perth & Smiths Falls District Hospital.

As we get set for 2020, we need your help with the challenge of raising over \$800,000 to meet our Hospital's current capital equipment needs.

List of equipment our medical teams have determined to be the most urgent:

- **Mammography Unit (\$137,552).** The unit is used exclusively for x-ray exams of the breast, with special accessories that allow only the breast to be exposed to the x-rays.
We have partnered with the Smiths Falls Community Hospital Foundation to raise these funds
- **Mammography Unit View System (\$5,936).** The system allows for the radiologist / specialist to view the images from the mammography unit.
- **Colonoscopes / Printer Endo Tower / Endoscopy Tower / HD Camera for 4K Tower (\$98,600).** Together these items make up the endoscopic program and are utilized to complete cancer screening, biopsies, minor medical intervention and to complete diagnosis.
- **Anaesthesia Machine / Monitors (\$260,000).** Essential to operations, the anaesthesia machine and monitors are required for all surgeries that are completed.
- **Echocardiography Viewing Unit (PACS) (\$101,890).** An echocardiogram is the use of ultrasound to examine the heart. This system allows the physician / cardiologist to view the images that have been taken during an echocardiogram.
- **Pulmonary Function Testing System Upgrade (\$11,600).** Pulmonary function tests (PFTs) are non-invasive tests that show how well the lungs are working. This type of testing assists with diagnosing disease processes such COPD.
